Purpose

The RiverWoods Auxiliary traces its roots back to 1915 when an Auxiliary was formed at Central Oak Heights as plans were made to open the Evangelical Home and Orphanage. Over the years its function has remained the same—dedication to improving the quality of life for the residents of the Home, now RiverWoods Senior Living Community. The Auxiliary continues to provide programs and equipment to enhance the lives of the residents, and also donates to the Benevolent Care Fund. RiverWoods is owned and operated by Albright Care Services, a non-profit organization affiliated in faith with the Susquehanna Conference of The United Methodist Church.

Membership

Membership in the Auxiliary is open to all persons who are interested in the well-being of the residents of RiverWoods, including residents and staff. Members pay annual dues as set by the Board of Directors of the RiverWoods Auxiliary. Currently dues are \$5.00 per year or \$40.00 for a lifetime membership.

Meetings

General meetings of the members of the Auxiliary are held on the fourth Tuesday of March, April, June, September, October and November. The meetings are held at 12 p.m. in Marlow Hall in the Nursing Care Center. Lunch is provided by RiverWoods.
